## Letter of Concern

#### 171/2020 BLANDIN

BE IT RESOLVED THAT a letter be sent to the Urban Board of Examiners and to UMAAS expressing concerns that the RM of Lake Lenore No. 399 has with urban administrator Heather Hind-Hluchaniuk:

- Referencing inactive legislation on new bylaws (Urban Municipalities Act, 1984 referenced on Town of St. Brieux Bylaw No. 7-2019, the Business License Bylaw)
- Poor ability to deal with the Public, resulting in a high number of Town of St. Brieux ratepayers seeking assistance from RM of Lake Lenore Administrator
- In her capacity as Secretary-Treasurer for the St. Brieux & District Fire Protection Association, which although outside of the scope of Administrator duties should follow the same procedures due to the fact that the Association is created by municipal bylaw:
  - Non-disclosure that she would be taking an audiorecording of the February 20, 2020 FPA meeting;
  - Improper minute-taking (recording names of those opposed to motions without a recorded vote having been requested prior to the vote being made; not noting when participants left meeting early; not naming movers of motions but showing motions as being carried);
  - Issuing payment for FPA accounts without Board approval for the payments;
  - Being generally rude to and uncooperative with the RM of Lake Lenore members on the FPA board.
